Designed For Our Environment

ECODESIGN READY STOVES & FIRES

We have always strived to create standout stoves and fires that not only provide superior flame visuals, but also minimise our environmental impact. Our advanced Cleanburn technology is the result of 38 years of experience and development, with many of our products approved for use in urban environments which are typically DEFRA smoke restricted areas.

However, producing DEFRA exempt appliances was only the beginning. New Ecodesign regulations are coming into force in 2022 to ensure stoves and fires burn with high efficiency and low emissions.

With this in mind, we have developed the Elise range to not only meet Ecodesign limits, but to go much further. Some models in the range burn so cleanly that emissions are minimised to as little as a fifth of the forthcoming 2022 requirements.

The Elise's advanced combustion system isolates air management in the specially designed base of the fire, so that airflow is calibrated precisely to ensure a far more complete burning process than standard fires can ever achieve. The result is significantly less flue gases that impact air quality, including Carbon Monoxide (CO), Nitrogen Oxide (NOx), Organic Gaseous Compounds (OGC), and Particulate Matter (PM).

We believe this is the future of solid fuel heating, which is why we offer the largest range of Ecodesign stoves and fires in the UK and Ireland.

THE BENEFITS OF WOODBURNING

Unlike fossil fuels, wood releases approximately the same amount of carbon into the atmosphere as that absorbed during its growth, making it a virtually carbon neutral heat source.

Choosing one of our high efficiency low emission Elise fires is a great step towards burning responsibly. To ensure your fire provides optimum heating performance, only wood with a low moisture content should be burnt. Seasoned logs should be allowed to dry for at least two years or more to achieve a moisture content below 20%, which can be easily checked with a moisture meter. When purchasing seasoned or kiln dried wood, look for the Woodsure "Ready to Burn" certification which guarantees logs will have less than 20% moisture.

Good quality dry wood will not only provide a higher heat output than that of freshly felled timber, it will also avoid a build-up of tar in your flue and ensure low smoke emissions with clean and crisp flames.

ENCOURAGING SUSTAINABLE WOODLAND

We are working with Certainly Wood, our recommended Woodsure "Ready to Burn" fuel supplier, who pride themselves on making an impact on environmental targets by championing sustainability.

When you register your new Elise, the Stovax Heating Group and Certainly Wood will jointly fund the planting of a tree. For more information, see page 31.

WOOD OR SMOKELESS FUEL

All Elise fires and stoves, including multi-fuel versions, are designed to burn wood with high efficiency. Elise cassette models are available in both dedicated woodburning versions and multi-fuel versions, which will allow you to burn either logs or smokeless fuel to suit your lifestyle.

SMOKE CONTROL AREA APPROVAL

Many town and city homes are located in DEFRA Smoke Control Areas as designated by the 1993 Clean Air Act. The Elise range has been approved for the burning of wood in these areas, meaning that even the most urban of homes can benefit from this natural fuel source.



CE MARKED & HETAS ACCREDITED

All stoves and fires in the Elise range are CE Marked. This means they have been independently tested to exacting European standards for both heating efficiency and emissions. In addition, they have also been accredited by HETAS, the UK's official body recognised by the government to approve solid fuel domestic heating appliances.





Precision Performance



Every Stovax stove and fire is characterised by a precise balance of efficiency, performance and user control. The Elise is the result of these elements being taken to new levels, to create a solid fuel fire at the forefront of innovation. Utilising a series of advanced plenum chambers coupled with powerful air jets, airflow is instantly adjusted and delivered with

precision accuracy to multiple areas of the tapered firebox. This technology facilitates the Elise's Ecodesign combustion process which reduces emissions to remarkably low amounts whilst maintaining high levels of thermal efficiency. The Elise's design also means they are DEFRA smoke control zone exempt, making them an excellent choice for rural and urban homes alike.

to draw any oxygen from the room. This potentially negates the need for an additional air vent, therefore minimising drafts.

FAN ASSISTED CONVECTION KIT

Installing an optional fan kit with your Elise fire helps circulate convection air, increasing burning efficiency and improving heat delivery into the room. With both manual and automatic settings, the fan kit is conveniently operated by the Elise Control Panel.

WARM AIR DUCTING KIT

With the addition of the warm air ducting kit, Elise fires are capable of heating up to two additional living spaces, allowing you to truly make the most of your fire and reduce your reliance on your central heating system.

Ecodesign limits are set to dramatically reduce the current UK Carbon Monoxide emission limits by a massive 88%, from $1\% @ 13\% O_2$ to 0.12%. All Elise models, again meet this stringent forthcoming standard.



ENERGY EFFICIENCY RATING

Additional Information

PHOTOGRAPHY AND INSTALLATION

Due to variations in studio lighting and printing inks, the finishes/colours of fires illustrated in this brochure may differ slightly from actual models. Before purchasing, please ask your retailer to show you finish/colour samples.

All of the flame pictures shown in this brochure are taken from real fires. Please note however that flame pictures will vary depending on the exact fuel used, flue conditions and surrounding geographical features. Given that building regulations are subject to constant change, some of the photography in this brochure may not comply with the requirements of the latest building regulations and you should always check your proposed installation arrangement with your HETAS trained installer before proceeding.

When designing your own installation, please also observe the minimum distance to combustible materials as stated in the installation instructions.

Stovax pursues a policy of continuous product improvement, therefore, whilst our products are correct at the time of the photography, we reserve the right to make alterations and amendments. Exact product details should be discussed with your retailer at the time of purchase.

The 'Nominal' heat output is to be used for calculating the ventilation provision as required by ADJ Building Regulations and for calculating its suitability for heating the size of room it will be fitted into. The heat output 'Range' is to be used as a guide only as the maximum and minimum performance will depend on local conditions such as flue pull, fuel quality and the way in which the product is used.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please note that all parts of these fires, particularly the glass panel in the door, become extremely hot during operation and can result in serious injury and burns if touched. It is therefore recommended that a fireguard complying with BS 8423:2002 is used in the presence of young children, the elderly or infirm. In addition, by law all installations also require a Carbon Monoxide monitor (such as product code 3045 available from Stovax).

EXTENDED WARRANTY
